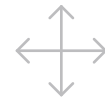

What is the Executive Report?

The Executive Report is a single-page report that shows key metric data for the past 30 days for your account. Gain a high-level overview of your computers and servers and instant insight into Windows updates, antivirus, OS type, disk space, remote control sessions, alerts, and security threats.

Pull a report for any computer group and view key metric data for the past 30 days including:



Enhance security

Pie charts for:

- **Windows Updates:** View which computers and servers are up to date, have optional updates pending, have important updates pending, have automatic updates turned off, and do not have a status available.
- **Antivirus:** View which computers have no threats detected, have threats detected, are unprotected, and unknown.
- **OS Type:** View what operating system each computer and server runs.
- **Free Disk Space:** View which computers and servers have below 10%, below 25%, below 50%, and more than 50% of disk space available.



Report on what matters

Bar charts for:

- **Remote Control:** View total remote control time and number of sessions held in the last 30 days.
- **Alerts:** View how many alerts were triggered and how many alerts were acknowledged in the last 30 days.
- **Security Threats:** View how many threats were detected and how many threats were acknowledged in the last 30 days.

Generate an Executive Report in 3 easy steps

1. Click **Reports** and then click **Executive** in the left-hand panel.
2. Select the computer group for which you'd like the Executive Report generated.
3. Click **Generate PDF file** or **Generate Word file** depending on the report type you'd like to create.
