What are Host Preference Packages?

Host Preference Packages allow you to define and deploy preferences and security settings to Windows hosts in your LogMeIn account.

Host Preference Package categories

Remote control: Determine whether to allow desktop sharing, remote sound, remote printing, blanking of the hosts computer and more.

Network: Set the idle time allowed, file-transfer compression levels, maximum number of servicing threads and more.

Appearance: Select which icons and features to show.

Access control: Choose to allow full control to administrators, save login credentials and more.

Log settings: Determine how long to keep log files, whether to record screen content for remote sessions and more.

IP address lockout: Lock out individuals after a specified number of invalid password attempts or HTTP requests.

Create a Host Preference Package in 4 simple steps

- 1. Select computers:** Under Configuration, go to the Host Preferences page and select **Add Package**.
Name your new Host Preference Package and click **Save**.
- 2. Select a category:** Choose the category for your Host Preference Package.
(These categories are outlined above.)
- 3. Choose your settings:** Within the category, customize your settings to best suit the needs of your organization.
- 4. Assign to computers or groups:** Next to the Host Preference Package you want to assign, select **Click here to assign** and choose the computers and groups using the left and right arrows.
